

Thank you also to the chapter members who came out to hear the wonderful recital on the Dobson organ. James Kealey used the resources of the organ masterfully, from the rousing rendition of the Buxtehude d minor praeludium, the elegant C major Trio Sonata, and the tour de force Etude Symphonique of Bossi. As winner of the NYACOP Kealey along with the AGO has released a CD entitled "Rhapsodic" recorded on the Hook and Hastings/Andover Organ at

St. Joseph Cathedral in Buffalo, NY. If you have a chance, it is well worth taking time to give it a listen.

Our next chapter event is November 12th at St. Francis Church. Mark Edwards will perform a recital on the historic Schuelke organ. It is a wonderful opportunity to hear this instrument from a Milwaukee organ builder that is still in its original place of installation. Mark Edwards, a graduate of Eastman School of Music (studying with Cecile Genhart) and Indiana University, has served on the piano faculties of Augustana College (SD), Carthage College, and Milwaukee Area Technical College, and as pianist and vocalist with the U.S. Air Force Band. Edwards and his wife, Karen Redekopp Edwards often perform as a piano duo and have released two CDs of duo piano music.
