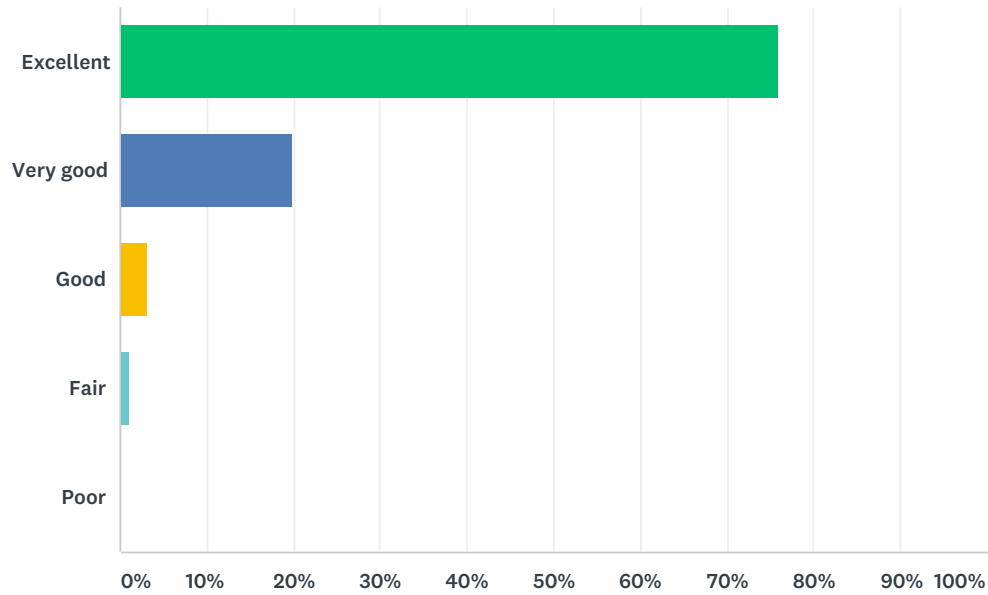

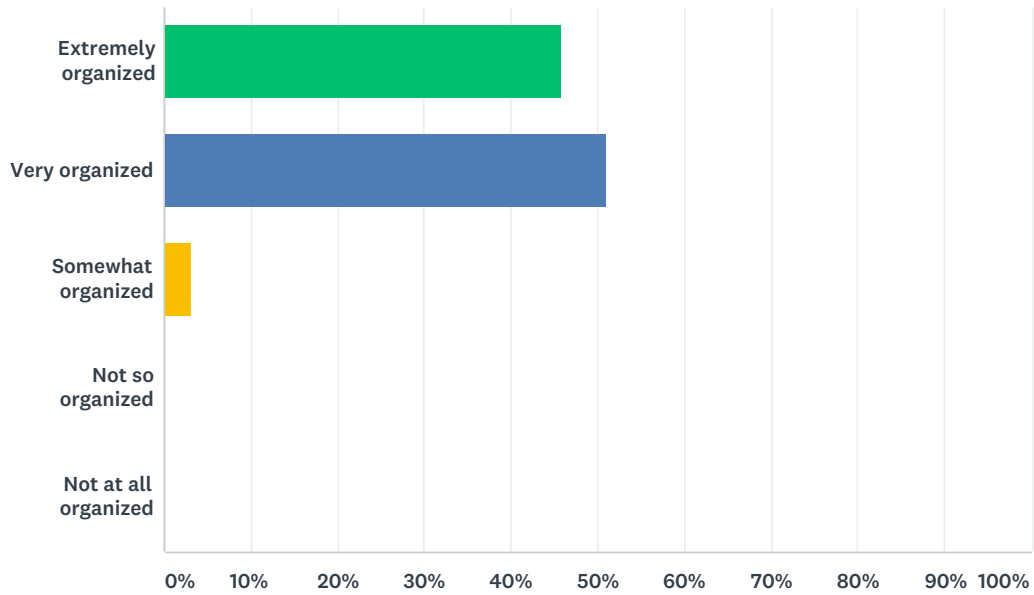

Q4 How organized was the event?

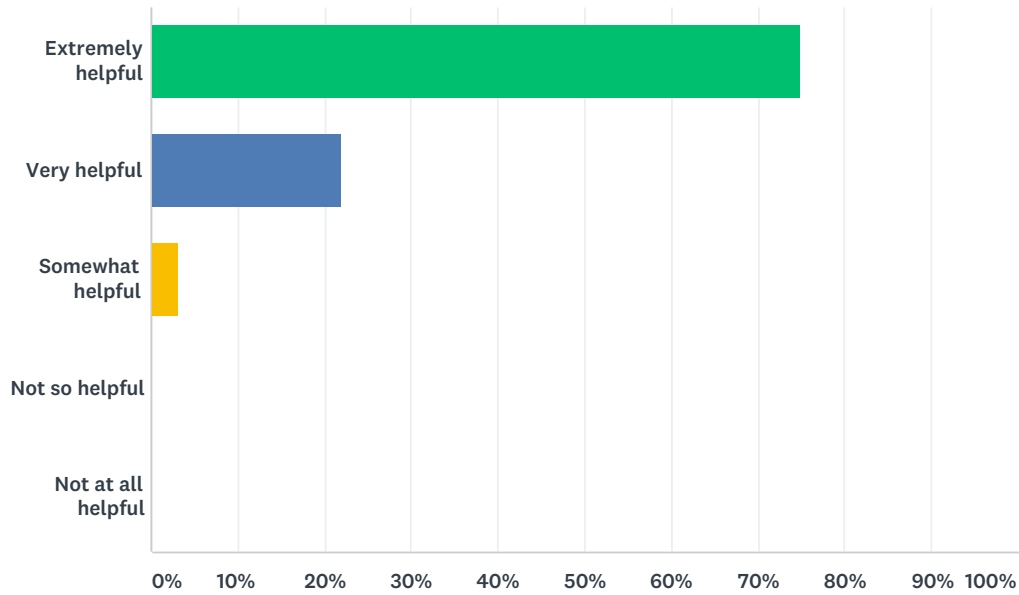

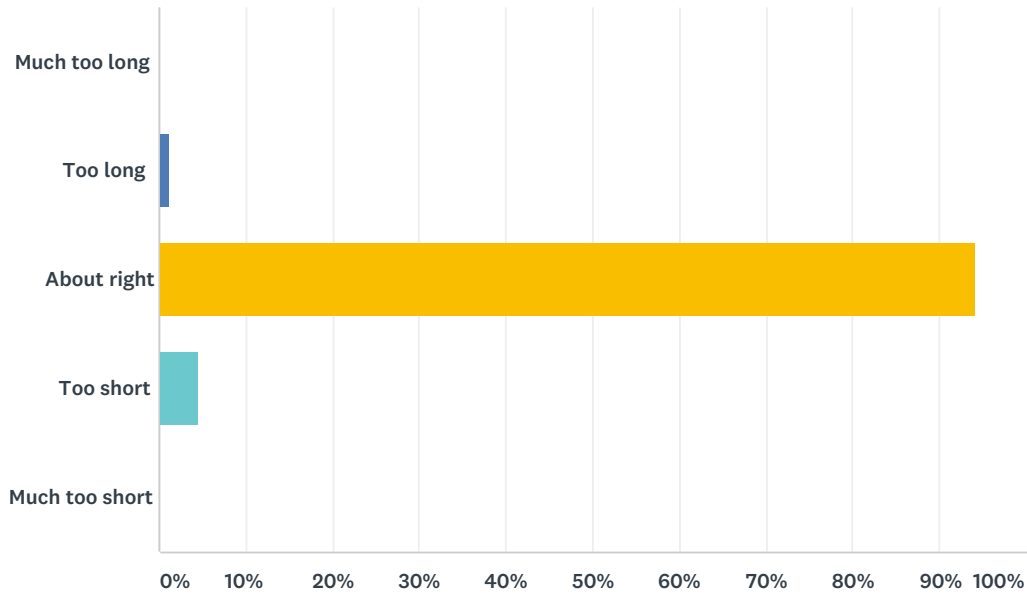

Q7 Were the Workshops too long, too short or about right?

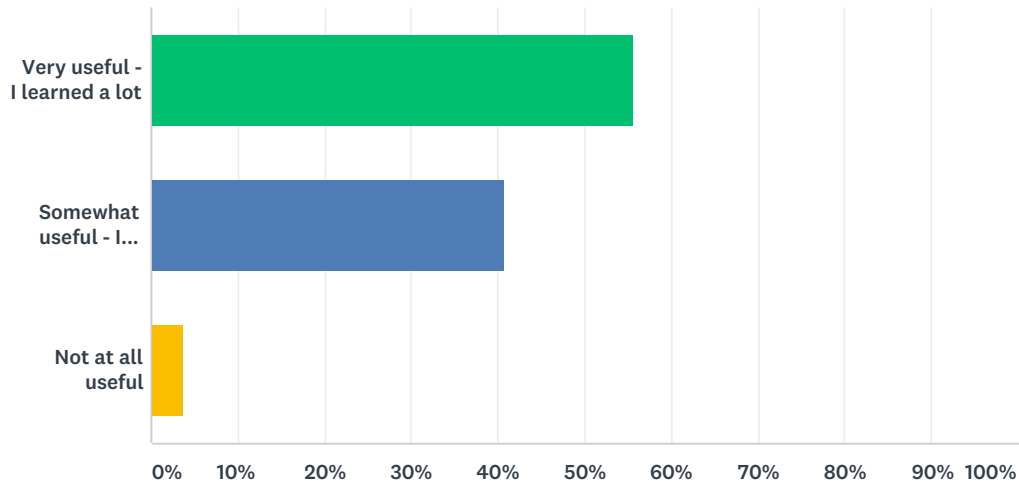

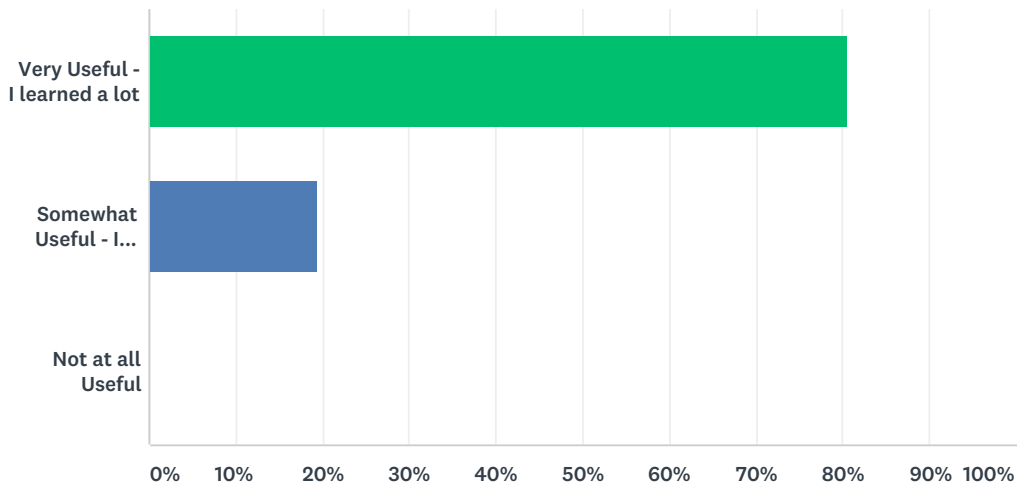

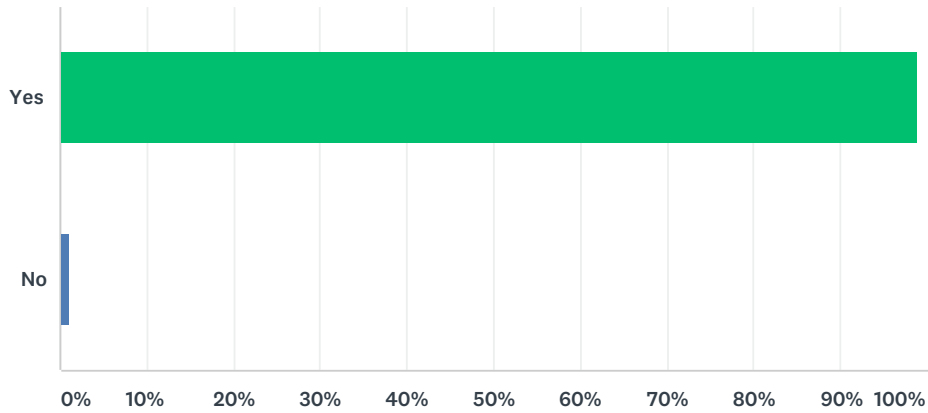
