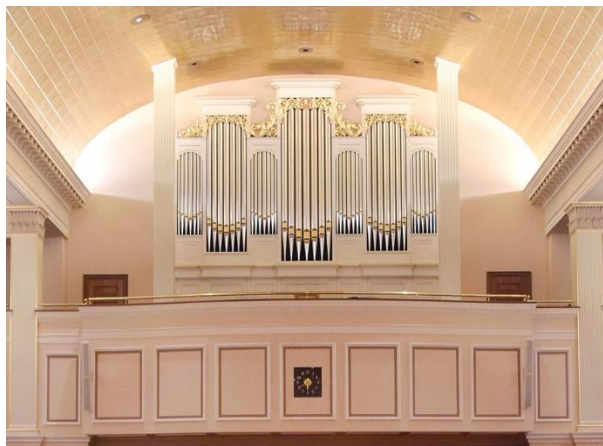

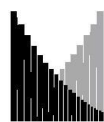

Thank you for your continued support! A question about renewing came forward in August. If you have further questions, please let myself or one of our board members know. It used to be that renewals were due July 1st. This is no longer the case; renewals come up yearly at the time you renewed previously, (i.e., I renew in August so every year that renewal comes in August; some people renew in January, etc.). *Our chapter would encourage you to renew in July previous to our program year because this allows us to count on financial support for programming in the coming year.*

You can begin on our chapter website, www.agomilwaukee.org, and follow the left hand menu to OnCard Renewal. This will take you to a page with a large button, "click here". By doing this you will be directed to the OnCard Renewal page on the national website. The directions for renewing online are very clear. You will need your member ID which is found just to the left of the date on the address label of The American Organist magazine; this serves as your password.

If you would like to renew as a chapter friend, you can use the current form on our local chapter website, www.agomilwaukee.org, dues are \$70. This helps to support our local chapter and you will receive only local chapter information.

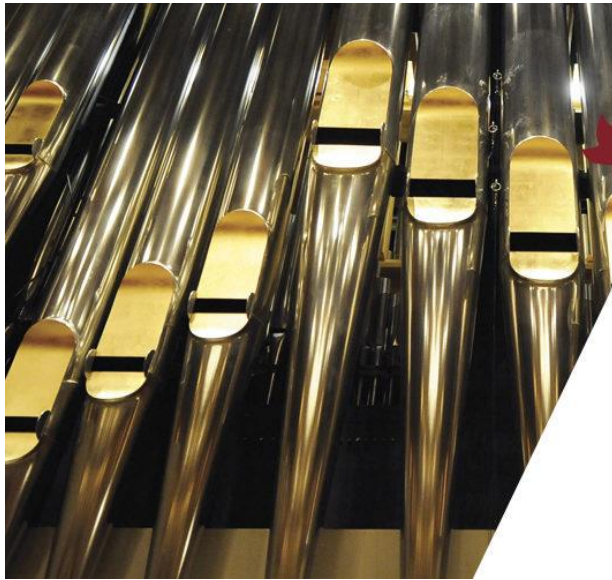
